Parade Rules

- Strict safety precautions and the adherence of these rules must be observed by all entries.
 Failure to abide by these may result in an entry to be removed from participating in the event.
 Violations during a parade attempted to be addressed first to promote the safety and welfare of the public, and then to the fair treatment of all participants by the Parade Director.
- The mission of Swartz Creek Hometown Days is to provide the best hometown festival, working with community partnerships to strengthen neighborhood families and to create an atmosphere where everyone feels safe and at home.
- ALL APPLICATIONS MUST BE RECEIVED NO LATER THAN MAY 16th. NO EXCEPTIONS.
 All applications must be made in writing or electronically to the Parade Director. Additions after this date will be invitation only at the discretion of the Parade Director.
- Only those with approved applications or invitations will be allowed to participate in the parade.
 Under no circumstance will bystanders be allowed to join the parade along its route.
- Any entries depicting discrimination or deemed to not be aligned with the values of Swartz Creek Hometown Days core principles will be asked not to participate by the Parade Director.
- The practice of parade participants jumping on and off a moving vehicle in the parade is prohibited.
- Handouts and candy are to be handed to the crowd not thrown from entries. Violations of this
 ordinance could result in prosecution and/or the denial of future requests.
- Absolutely no water will be sprayed, splashed, or thrown into the crowd. An incident of this may result in confiscation of the item or removal of the entry from the route.
- All entries having music or sound amplifying systems shall maintain a volume that will not interfere with other entries.
- Large entries may be asked to arrive with additional spotters (people) walking to monitor the safety of participants and parade viewers.
- Groups of more than 20 walkers must be approved by the Parade Director.
- No entry may exceed 12 feet in height due to traffic lights and power lines on streets, in addition to 20 feet in width.
